1. Purpose of report:

To consider the objection notices to the Temporary Event Notice (TEN), which seeks to permit the sale of alcohol (for consumption off the premises), the provision of regulated entertainment and late night refreshment, to operate from 6:00pm until 3:00am on 19th June 2021 to 21st June 2021.

2. Recommendation:

To consider the objection notices made by West Midlands Police and Environmental Health.

3. Brief Summary of Report:

A Temporary Event Notice was submitted by Bobby Dhunay and received on 4th June 2021 in respect of Lord Street Car Park, Proctor Street, Birmingham, B7 4ED.

Objection notices have been received from West Midlands Police and Environmental Health.

4. Compliance Issues:

When carrying out its licensing functions, a licensing authority must have regard to the guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.

4.1 Consistency with relevant Council Policies, Plans or Strategies:

The report complies with the City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Council's Corporate Plan to improve the standard of all licensed persons, premises and vehicles in the City.

5. Relevant background/chronology of key events:

A Temporary Event Notice was submitted on 4th June 2021 by Bobby Dhunay, in respect of Lord Street Car Park, Proctor Street, Birmingham, B7 4ED, which was served on the responsible authorities on 4th June 2021.

The Temporary Event Notice is attached at Appendix 1.

Objection notices have been received from West Midlands Police and Environmental Health, see Appendices 2 & 3.

Site location plans are attached, see Appendix 4.

Under the licensing system of TENs, no actual permission is required to carry out a licensable activity on a temporary basis. An applicant must merely give notice of his intentions to operate a licensable activity to the licensing authority.

However, the police or local authority exercising environmental health functions may intervene to prevent such an event taking place or agree a modification of the proposed arrangements, and their intervention may in some cases result in the licensing authority imposing conditions on a TEN.

Where a TEN is submitted, the licensing authority must consider the objection(s) at a hearing before a counter notice, or a notice including a statement of conditions can be issued.

Conditions may only be applied if the TEN is in connection with licensable activities at licensed premises. It must be noted a Premises Licence is not currently in force for Lord Street Car Park, Proctor Street, Birmingham, B7 4ED.

When giving a TEN, consideration should be given to the following four licensing objectives:

- 1. The prevention of crime and disorder
- 2. Public safety
- 3. The prevention of public nuisance; and
- 4. The protection of children from harm
