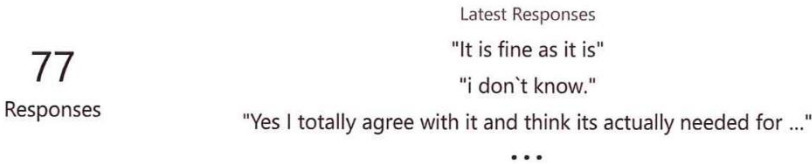

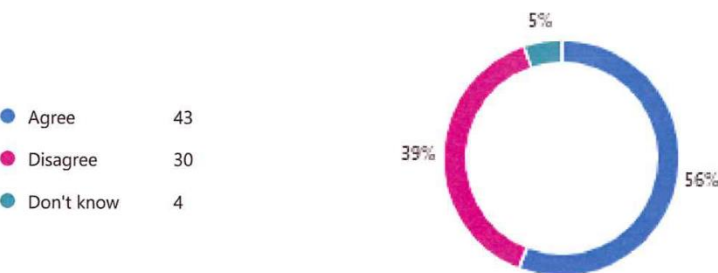

Do you agree or disagree that drivers of hackney carriage vehicles (taxi's) should have the ability to accept payment by both cash and electronic means?



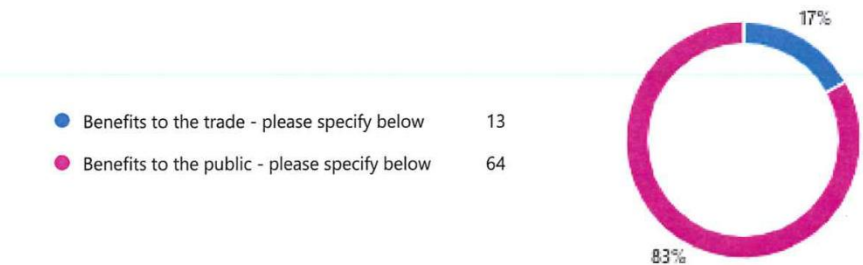
