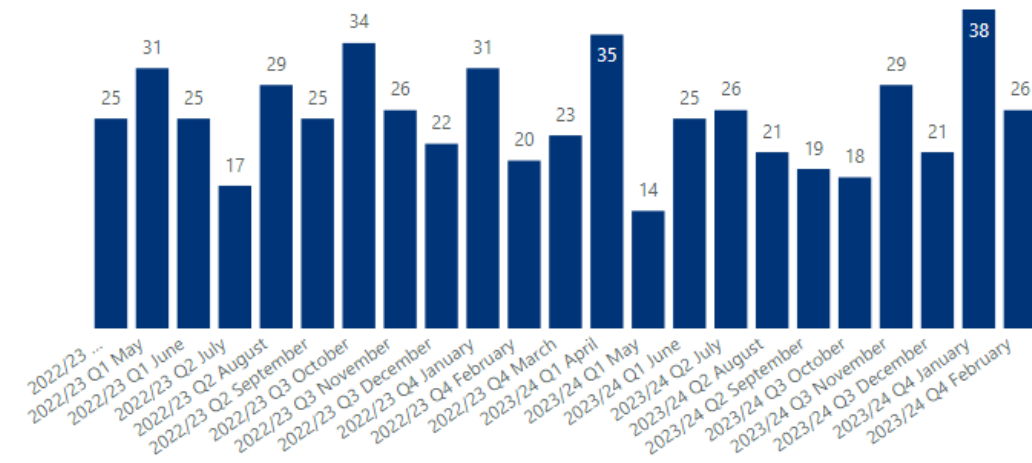

5. Protection

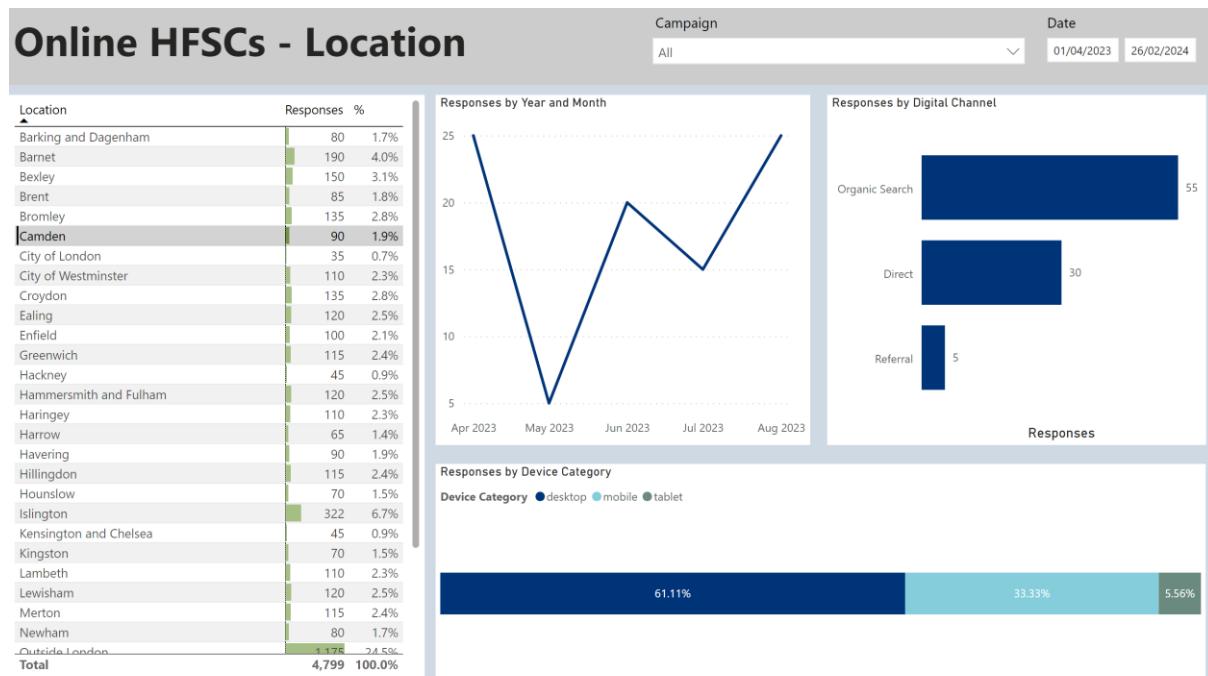
5.1 Fire Safety Checks are visits to local businesses by our operational crews to offer advice on fire safety and report any concerns.
