APPENDIX A

Allocation of Reserves

In 2023/24 there are proposals for a net contribution to our total reserves of £53.366m. The main contribution to reserves is a transfer of section 31 grants totalling £37.282m, received from Central Government for Business Rates reliefs in 2023/24. This reserve will be fully utilised in 2024/25 to meet the Collection Fund Deficit caused by the reduction in business rates paid due to the national rate relief issued.

The end of year contributions relating to services are driven by a combination of £4.839m of NHS funding transferred to the Better Care Fund, this is ringfenced funding to be spent across NHS and Council services, £0.988m to support future Public Health services, a net contribution of £1.256m to the Housing Revenue Account, a combined amount of £6.576m to the Dedicated Schools Grant and School Balances reserves.
