- e) Films
- f) Anything similar to live music, recorded music or performances of dance

10:00 – 00:00 Friday and Saturday
11:00 – 22:30 Sunday
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#### g) Opening hours

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07:00 – 02:00 Monday to Saturday 07:00 – 00:00 Sunday
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### 2. Representations

- 2.1 One hundred and ninety eight relevant representations have been received in relation to the application.
- 2.2 One hundred and fifty representations oppose the application and these are from local ward councillors, resident associations, community groups and organisations, businesses, and local residents.
- 2.3 Forty eight representations support the application and these are from local businesses, various institutes and local residents.

3.2 The premises is not situated in a cumulative impact policy area.

3.3 The hours policy is engaged by this application in relation to the proposed terminal times for licensable activities. The framework hours are given in the policy as:

#### On Sales

Monday to Thursday 10:00 until 23:30 Friday and Saturday 10:00 until midnight 11:00 until 22:30

#### No sale or supply of alcohol

Monday to Thursday 09:00 until 23:30 Friday and Saturday 09:00 until midnight 09:00 until 22:30

3.4 The times for the framework hours on any given day are not (and should not be regarded as) the "usual" or "normal" working hours for licensable activities in the Borough. Instead, the framework hours serve to identify those cases where the Licensing Authority will pay particular regard to the likely effect on the local neighbourhood of carrying out the proposed licensable activities.

#### Women's Safety (Appendix One – Page 88 to 89 of the Policy)

3.5 The Council has adopted a set of principles that commit our licensed premises to act in a responsible manner, taking all forms of female

harassment seriously and set out the practical steps licensed premises can take to support this.
