1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. This report (appendix A) provides an update on primary care dental services, urgent dental care delivery, community dental services in Camden, and secondary care and Level 2 complexity dental services.
- 1.2 This is an update regarding the provision in Camden following a previous presentation to the committee in September 2023 following the decision in April 2023 for North Central London Integrated Care Board (NCL ICB), along with all ICBs, to take over responsibility for the commissioning of Dental, Optometry and Community Pharmacy Services (collectively referred to as POD or DOP services).

2. Background

- 2.1 The report, regarding dental services within Camden was previously presented to the committee in 2023. This report is an update on dental services available to residents within Camden.
- 2.2 Appendix A, Camden Dental Report August 2025, provides an overview of Dentistry across the borough including General Dental Services (GDS), Personal Dental Services (PDS), specialities and community dental services. The report also contains an update on where services are at now in the context of the roadmap to recovery of dental services post pandemic. The report goes into further detail around areas of concern such as prevalence of dental decay in 5-year-old school children, local pilot initiatives and other considerations such as dental charges, waiting lists, contracting and staffing.
