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## PURPOSE OF ITEM

To receive a briefing on the new Adult Social Care performance dashboards.

## OUTLINE

Performance reporting for local government has changed and become less regulated in terms of overall Council performance over a number of years, though tight monitoring and regulation remains in a number of services such as Children's and Adult services. The current Government is proposing a new Local Government Outcomes Framework which seeks to re-introduce some of what has been removed over time. This is subject to consultation.

The Council recognised that it needed to improve its corporate performance management and has brought in a new performance framework and started the journey to improve its performance reporting and accessibility of that data.

At Scrutiny Panel in October it was agreed that while it would still take the overall '*Organisational Health*' dashboards, the '*Business Critical Dashboards*' would go to relevant Commissions. The Adults Health and Integration related dashboards will from now on come to Health in Hackney.

This report sets out a performance summary against the 'business critical performance dashboard' for Adult Social Care. The dashboard covers four main performance areas that are considered critical drivers for the Council. The data presented is at December 2025 and includes areas such as funded packages of care by type, completion and throughput of Care Act related assessments and reviews, waiting lists for assessment and number of safeguarding enquiries.
