1. **Summary**

### Notes for Guidance

**This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates.   - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
  - Live music: no licence permission is required for:

- a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
- a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
- a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
  - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
  - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;

- any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
  - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
  - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

**Police make the following representations in relation to the application to vary the Premises Licence at Local Supermarket for the following reason(s);**

**The Police submit this representation objecting to the above application on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder and the protection of public safety. The application seeks a significant extension to the terminal hour for alcohol off-sales, well beyond the Council's adopted Core Hours and the framework set out under Policy LP4, which generally restricts off-sales of alcohol to between 08:00 and 23:00.**

**This premises is located within a densely populated borough where late-night off-sales have been clearly identified by both the Police and Public Health as contributing to increased levels of anti-social behaviour, street drinking and alcohol-related disorder, particularly during the late-night and early-morning period. Extending the sale of alcohol to 01:00 and 02:00 would, in the Police view, directly undermine the licensing objectives by increasing the availability of alcohol at times when the likelihood of nuisance and disorder is greatest.**

**The Police are particularly concerned that this application has been submitted in circumstances where the premises has only recently been subject to enforcement action. In December 2025 / January 2026, the premises was issued with a formal warning letter by the Local Authority following the sale of counterfeit cigarettes, an offence which raises serious concerns regarding management standards, compliance with the law, and the ability of the premises to promote and uphold the licensing objectives. While the matter was dealt with by way of a warning and the seizure of items, the Police view that the premises was fortunate not to face more severe enforcement action.**

**Given this recent history, the Police do not have confidence that the premises is currently being operated in a sufficiently responsible or professional manner to justify a further relaxation of controls on the sale of alcohol. The commission of a criminal offence, even where dealt with by warning, calls into question the integrity of the management and their willingness or ability to operate within the boundaries of the law. This is directly relevant when considering an application to extend hours for alcohol sales, particularly off-sales, which are known to be higher risk.**

**The Police also note that the application offers no additional conditions or enhanced control measures to mitigate the increased risks associated with later trading hours. There are no proposals to strengthen management controls, staff training, supervision, or engagement with responsible authorities. In the absence of robust and proactive measures, the Police consider the application to be poorly reasoned and opportunistic, particularly in light of the premises' recent compliance issues.**

**In summary, the requested extension represents a departure from the Council's policy on off-sales, would increase the availability of alcohol during high-risk hours, and is sought by a premises with a recent history of unlawful activity. For these reasons, the Police do not believe the applicant has demonstrated that the licensing objectives will be upheld, and accordingly object to the application in full**

The Licensing Authority submits the following comments in relation to the application.

The applicant, in this variation application is seeking to extend the provision of alcohol sales Off the premises for an additional hour from Sunday to Wednesday and two additional hours on Thursday to Saturday.

The Licensing Authority notes the high density of licensed premises in the area and close proximity to residential premises, with flats located above the premises along the commercial parade.

The current licence already benefits from authorisation beyond LP3 Core Hours whilst being located in a LP11 Special Consideration Area. The applicant has not demonstrated in the application that they have taken these factors into account.

The combination of location and extended hours, may lead to the promotion of the licensing objective being undermined.

**LP3 Core Hours**

*Hours for licensable activity will generally be authorised, subject to demonstrating LP1 and LP2, as follows:*

- *Monday to Thursday 08:00 to 23:00*
- *Friday and Saturday 08:00 to 00:00*
- *Sunday 10:00 to 22:30*

*Hours may be more restrictive dependent on the character of the area and if the individual circumstances require it.*

*Later hours may be considered where the applicant has identified any risk that may undermine the promotion of the licensing objectives and has put in place robust measures to mitigate those risks. It should be noted that this policy does not apply to those who are making an application within a special policy area (see section 3) unless they have been able to demonstrate that the proposed activity or operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact that is already being experienced.*

## **Objection to Extended Alcohol Licence – Local Supermarket, 140–142 Kingsland High Street, London E8 2NS**

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to object to the application for an extended alcohol licence at the above premises.

I live directly opposite the shop at [REDACTED] Alvington Crescent, where I have lived for the past 10 years. My home [REDACTED] the private residential driveway that serves both the residential flats at 75 A–D and also what the shop use as their main entrance and exit for deliveries and staff.

I want to make clear that I do not object lightly. I understand that local businesses are an important part of the community, and I do not wish to cause unnecessary difficulty for anyone trying to run a business.

However, the shop's current operations already cause significant disturbance to nearby residents, particularly late at night and extending the alcohol licence would make these problems worse and further affect the peace, safety and wellbeing of the local community.

### **Ongoing Public Disturbance**

Since the shop was granted its 12am alcohol licence, and more recently since the shop's internal stairwell from the ground floor to the basement was removed, noise and has increased significantly. The shop relies heavily on rear access and uses the fire escape serving the flats above as the main access between floors, which has increased disturbance at the back of the premises.

The main issues include:

- **Rear door noise**  
Loud metal doors on both floors at the rear the shop are repeatedly opened and slammed closed throughout the day and late into the night. The noise echoes through the rear area and sends shock wave vibrations right through my flat and walls, particularly when staff exit the shop late at night and enter early morning and often disturbs sleep.
- **Delivery, vehicle disruption and noisy activities**  
The shop uses the shared private driveway for a delivery van, which is usually parked there daily from the afternoon until late evening. It regularly leaves the premises between approximately 11pm and 1am, causing disturbance through loud engines,

loud voices, and the screeching of the adjoining iron gates opening and closing next to my flat. If the licence is extended, I am concerned that later trading will lead to more frequent deliveries, vehicle movements and more late-night activities, noise and disruption.

- **Persistent fan noise and vibration**

Industrial fans at the rear of the shop create low-frequency noise, pulsating machine noises and vibrations that runs 24 hours a day. At certain points, the fan cycles overlap or harmonise, producing a louder and more intrusive disturbance.

This causes a constant background disturbance that can be felt through walls, windows and ventilation outlets in nearby flats. Since the removal of the internal stairs, there appears to be reduced airflow between the two shop floors, and in hot weather the fans seem to work harder to support the fridges and freezers, particularly after staff have left the premises. At night, the noise can feel extremely intrusive, sometimes like jet engines, and I must play ambient music every night in order to sleep as I feel I am laying in a bed of pulsating sub bass frequencies.

On the front of the shop there is a sign asks customers to respect neighbours by leaving quietly, but the operators themselves make no effort to do so.

## **Impact on the Local Community and Residential Area**

An extension of the licence would mean activity from around 6am until 1–2am each day, leaving only a very short period of quiet overnight. This would further affect the residential character of Alvington Crescent and expose residents to longer periods of noise and disturbance.

The surrounding area already experiences regular delivery and traffic noise from morning through to evening. Residents are entitled to night-time quiet, which this license extension would remove entirely, particularly in the rear residential areas away from the main road.

I am also concerned that later alcohol sales may increase late-night footfall, antisocial behaviour and security risks around the rear of the premises and neighbouring homes. A bicycle was recently stolen at the rear of the premises at the back area of the driveway, and increased late-night activity would draw further attention to this private residential area.

## **Personal and Health Impact**

I work from home and live with ongoing medical conditions, for which I receive PIP and LCWRA support. The ongoing noise and vibration have a serious impact on my concentration, rest, sleep, mental health and general wellbeing.

I have previously tried to raise concerns directly with the shop but found these attempts difficult and they were met with hostility. As a result, I no longer feel able to approach the owners directly about these issues.

I am also concerned that other neighbours may feel similarly reluctant to object or raise concerns, even where they are affected. Even in submitting this objection, I feel anxious

about the possibility of aggressive reactions or blame being directed towards me. This is one reason I believe it is important for the council to consider the impact on residents carefully and ensure that concerns can be raised safely and fairly.

## **Conclusion**

I respectfully ask the council to refuse this application.

In my view, the existing late trading already causes persistent noise, nuisance and disturbance. Extending the alcohol licence would intensify these issues and further undermine the wellbeing and community spirit of this residential area.

Hackney's strong sense of community is one of the reasons I have valued living here for the past decade. I believe that protecting that community means ensuring that local businesses operate in a way that respects the residents who live directly around them.

Thank you for your email regarding the licensing application for Local Supermarket, [140-142 Kingsland High Street.E8 2NS](#).

I do not feel able to attend the Sub Committee meeting in person due to previous hostile encounters with the supermarket owners. I understand other neighbours you have informed feel the same.

I ask that our concerns are fully represented at the meeting. There is a long history of disturbance from this premises, particularly the industrial fans at the rear of the property, which have caused ongoing noise and low-frequency vibration. These were required to be removed in late 2024 (Ref: 2024/0280/ENF) by the Planning Permission Department, but were reinstalled around eight months later without planning permission and have continued to cause problems.

I have attached a noise diary showing the dates, times, and nature of the disturbances. The current licence does not permit deliveries between 18:00 and 08:00, yet much of the recorded delivery activity and noise has taken place during those hours. This is especially concerning because the rear of the premises, used as the shop's main entrance and exit, backs onto a residential area.

For these reasons, I object to any extension of licensed hours where this would increase late-night or early-morning activity, deliveries, or noise disturbance.

Please confirm that these concerns and the attached evidence will be taken into account at the Sub Committee meeting, and that my inability to attend in person will not affect the weight given to this objection.

I am writing as a resident living [REDACTED] the 'Local supermarket' 140-142 Kingsland High Street to formally object to the proposed extension of its licence in the late hours.

Whilst I understand the commercial motivations behind this application, I must highlight the significant and ongoing impact this would have on the quality of life for residents in the immediate vicinity.

The supermarket currently generates considerable noise disturbance during its late-night closing routine, including loud door slamming, delivery van movements, the loading and unloading of goods and loud communication, all in extremely close proximity to residential flats. Extending operating hours until 1 and 2 am would mean this disturbance occurring at a time when residents are most likely to be asleep, causing serious disruption to rest and wellbeing.

Beyond noise, I would also draw attention to the significant levels of antisocial behaviour already present in this area. Both the high street and the street behind the supermarket are well-known hotspots for antisocial activity, particularly during late-night hours. Extending the supermarket's licence risks further encouraging congregation and disturbance in these spaces at a time when there is little to no deterrent, directly impacting the safety and wellbeing of local residents.

My final and most significant concern relates to access to our flats. Currently, there is an unattended internal door connecting the supermarket directly to the flat entrance, which remains open at all times during business hours. While some residents use this route as a shortcut to the high street, it poses a serious security risk, it bypasses the main front door entirely, meaning anyone can reach the flat entrance without needing to use a fob key. This critically undermines the safety of both our flats and our bikes. .

Dalston is already a busy and vibrant area, and residents living above or adjacent to commercial premises already tolerate a significant level of noise and disruption. Extending this licence would push that tolerance well beyond what is reasonable, particularly given the physical proximity of the supermarket to our homes.

I respectfully urge the licensing authority to refuse this application, or at the very minimum, to impose strict conditions around noise management, delivery times, staff conduct during closing hours, and measures to address antisocial behaviour in the surrounding area.

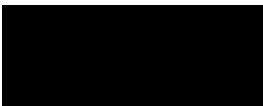

## Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

### Supply Of Alcohol(Off)

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
  - (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence.
  - (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3.
  - 3.1. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sales or supply of alcohol.
  - 3.2 The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licences must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
  - 3.3. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:-
    - (a) a holographic mark or
    - (b) an ultraviolet feature.

### Minimum Drinks Pricing

4.
  - 4.1 A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
  - 4.2 For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 4.1 above -
    - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
    - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula -  $P = D + (D \times V)$   
Where -
      - (i) P is the permitted price,
      - (ii) D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
      - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
    - (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
      - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
      - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
      - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
    - (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or

officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and  
(e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

4.3 Where the permitted price given by Paragraph 4.2(b) above would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4.4 (1) Sub-paragraph 4.4(2) below applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph 4.2(b) above on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

### **Conditions derived from Responsible Authority representations**

5. The premises shall maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of a Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. All public areas, entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer.
6. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show Police or an authorised officer of Hackney Borough Council recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
7. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available immediately to an authorised officer of the Hackney Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
  - a. all crimes reported to the venue
  - b. any complaints received
  - c. any refusal of alcohol sale
  - d. any incidents of disorder
  - e. any faults in the CCTV system
  - f. any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
8. All instances of crime or disorder to be reported by the premises licence holder or responsible member of staff to an agreed police contact point, as agreed with the Police.
9. There shall be prominent signage requesting customers to leave quietly and respect local residents.
10. The premises shall adhere to Hackney Police Weapons and Drugs Policies and any updates thereof.
11. The front and immediate surrounding area of the premises shall be kept clean and swept at the close of business each day.
12. The licence holder shall maintain a dedicated telephone number of the Duty Manager for use by any responsible authority or any person wishing to make a complaint. This number shall be provided to the licensing authority, police or local resident upon request.
13. There shall always be a personal licence holder on duty whenever alcohol is available for sale.
14. Where the sale or supply of alcohol is taking place, employees of the premises must request sight of evidence of the age of any person appearing to be under

25 years of age (Challenge 25). Such evidence may include a driving licence or passport.

15. All staff will be given refresher training every twelve months on the legislation relating to the sale of alcohol to underage persons and drunken persons. Written records of this training shall be kept on the premises and produced to police or other authorised officer upon request.
16. The Licensee shall ensure that all staff are fully trained and made aware of the legal requirement of businesses to comply with their responsibility as regards the disposal of waste produced from the business premises. The procedure for handling and preparing for disposal of the waste shall be in writing and displayed in a prominent place where it can be referred to at all times by staff.
17. The Licensee shall ensure that any contract for general and recyclable waste disposal shall be appropriate in size to the amount of waste produced by the business. The Licensee shall maintain an adequate supply of waste receptacles provided by his registered waste carrier (refuse sacks or commercial waste bins) in order to ensure all refuse emanating from the business is always presented for collection by his waste carrier and shall not use any plain black or unidentifiable refuse sacks or any other unidentifiable or unmarked waste receptacles.
18. In order to minimise the amount of time any waste remains on the public highway in readiness for collection, the Licensee will ensure the timeframe within which it may expect its waste carrier to collect is adhered to.
19. The Licensee shall instruct members of staff to make regular checks of the area immediately outside the premises and remove any litter, bottles and glasses emanating from the premises. A final check should be made at close of business.
20. The Licensee shall provide a safe receptacle for cigarette ends to be placed outside for the use of customers, such receptacle being carefully placed so as not to cause an obstruction or trip.
21. The current trade waste agreement/duty of care waste transfer document shall be conspicuously displayed and maintained in the window of the premises where it can be conveniently seen and read by persons standing in 140-142 Kingsland High Street. This should remain unobstructed at all times and should clearly identify:-
  - the name of the registered waste carrier
  - the date of commencement of trade waste contract
  - the date of expiry of trade waste contract
  - the days and times of collection
  - the type of waste including the European Waste Code













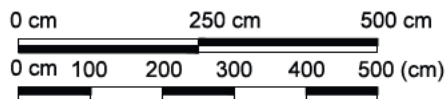
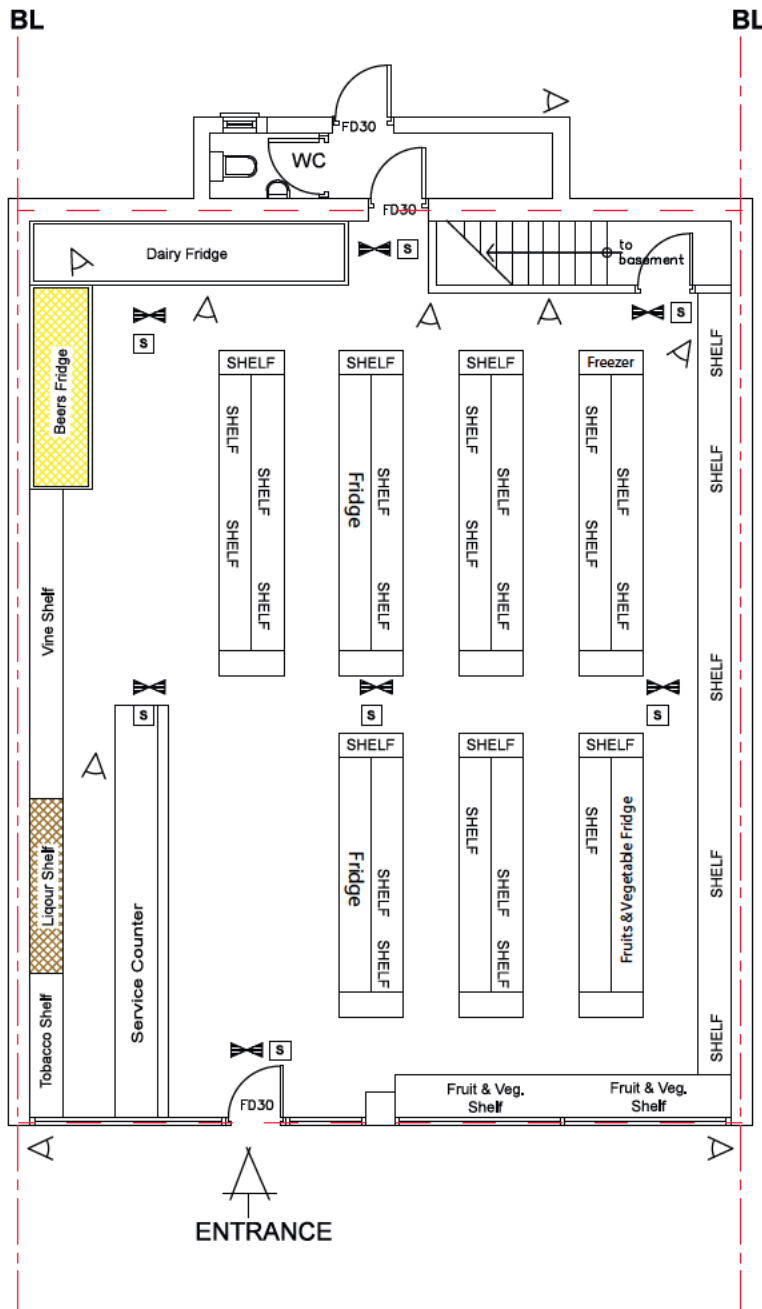
22. Deliveries will not be made to the premises between the hours of 18:00 to 08:00 hours.

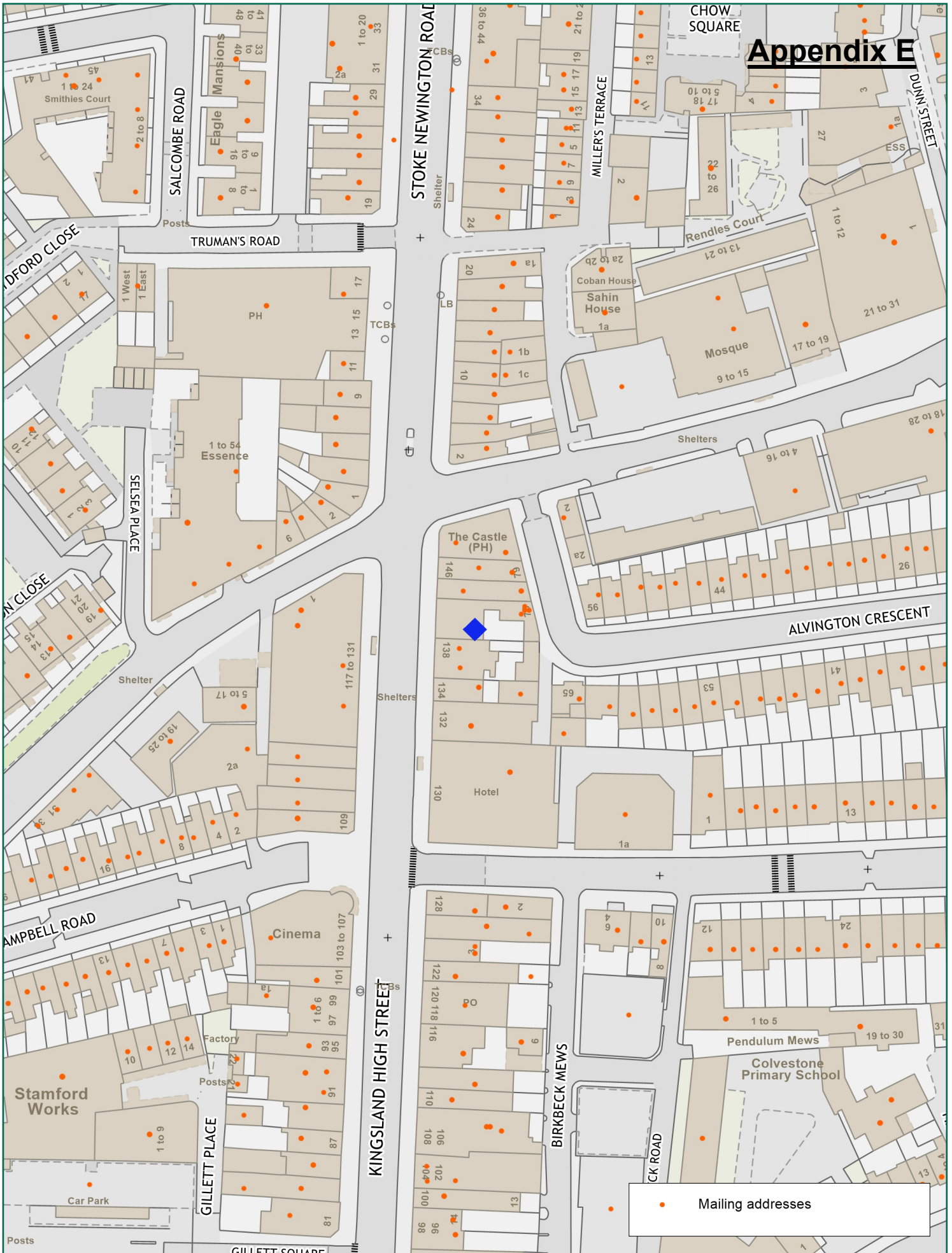
