We live in a very small community which is Lochranza Croft, Great Barr, many of us have lived here for over 30 years and up until now have lived quite happily as a community.

We have had properties in our Croft that have had extensions but these have always been kept within proportion of the Croft and no objections have been raised.

We now find ourselves being impacted by the above planning application which will affect several of us, my lives in the house adjacent to the proposed extension.

My mental health has moderate and if this proposal goes ahead this will impact significantly on mental health as it will impact on the light that property, therefore a significant change to environment potentially impacting on recognition of night and day.

We manage health and try to keep environment clean and prevent with the significant amount of work being proposed environment would be impacted.

is becoming increasingly mythered by this proposal again which will impact mental health.

We ourselves will be impacted by loss of light into our home, there are implications for the drainage system within the Croft as we often unblock our own drains within the Croft as they are so shallow. Parking is already a nightmare and will only be impacted further by the above proposal whilst work is ongoing if it is approved.

mental health is also being impacted due to this significant build which have numerous implications for . There are numerous other issues relating to this application too many to mention in this correspondence.

We have lodged our objections along with correspondence from [REDACTED] advisor, however the above application has been put forward for consideration on the 22 March 2023 which we are extremely concerned maybe approved.

These plans are amended from a proposed 5 bed to 4 bed property but the volume of the extension is concerning.
