

Notice of Motion – 25 February 2025

Motion Title: Prohibition of Off-Road Bike Storage and Illegal Use in Council Tenancies

Proposer: Councillor Williams **Seconder:** Councillor Wilkes

"Council notes that:

- 1. The misuse of off-road bikes, quad bikes, and other non-roadworthy motorized vehicles in public spaces, including roads, footpaths, and parks, poses a significant nuisance and safety risk to residents.
- 2. There have been increasing reports of illegal and anti-social use of such vehicles, leading to damage to public property, disturbances in the community, and risks to pedestrians and other road users.
- 3. Many of these vehicles are stored within council properties, including gardens, garages, and shared areas, enabling their continued unlawful use.

Council believes that:

- 1. Stronger tenancy conditions are necessary to prevent the storage and use of offroad bikes that contribute to anti-social behaviour and illegal activity.
- 2. Tenants should be held accountable if vehicles stored at their property are found to be used unlawfully on public roads or common areas.
- 3. Enforcement measures should be clearly outlined to deter the storage and illegal use of off-road bikes.

Council therefore resolves to call on the Leader and Cabinet to explore options to:

- 1. Create a new tenancy condition prohibiting the storage of off-road bikes, quad bikes, or other non-roadworthy motorized vehicles within council tenancies.
- 2. Implement enforcement measures including written warnings, financial penalties, property inspections, and potential termination of tenancy for repeated breaches.
- 3. Provide clear communication to all council tenants regarding the new tenancy condition and the consequences of non-compliance.
- 4. Work with local enforcement agencies to identify and address instances of illegal off-road vehicle use in council-managed areas."
