MOTIONS SUBMITTED TO COUNCIL UNDER PROCEDURE RULE 14

The following motions have been received in accordance with Council Procedure Rule 14:-

A) Improving Standards and Member Behaviour at SBC

(Moved by Councillor Hulme, seconded by Councillor Mann)

"The Council resolves;

1. To welcome the government's recent consultation to make local government 'fit, legal and decent', particularly in relation to the proposals to improve the standard of conduct regime;
2. To reaffirm its commitment that harassment, bullying, misogyny, sexism, racism, homophobia, ableism or age discrimination has no place in Slough;
3. To implement an enhanced Member's Pledge, setting out the principles expected of all elected members, with input from all political groups;
4. That mandatory training is delivered on combating the areas highlighted above, with attendance reported on the SBC website;
5. That SBC sign up to the LGA Debate not Hate Campaign."
