C3232 attended venue with APS Ben was the Manager at the time of our visit. Contacted the PLH by phone & I explained that we were conducting a Licensing check to him. During my initial conversation with the PLH I told him that I was aware of the Immigration visit on the 11/1/25 & that Officers had spoken to a land requested CCTV & that this person was obstructive & could not gain access to the CCTV. The PLH told me this was his cousin to told the PLH that I expected full co-operation from all staff when Officers request CCTV to which I was told that they do. I told the PLH that we needed to check the CCTV system & was told that would have to contact the CCTV company to give him access. Will be checked the date & time which was correct. I told the PLH that this wasn't good enough & that the Manager/Supervisor needs to know how to work the system as CCTV may be requested by Officers for any serious incidents that may occur on the premises. Premise Summary was on display. The ID scanner was switched off when we attended & linformed us that this is only used for the Shisha customers. I informed of the condition on the Licence - that all customers ID will be checked on entry. I told him I would be speaking to the PLH about this. Was not aware of where the Refusals register was (condition 3) & he didn't know where the door staff signing in register was (condition 6).  Premises Response – what part did staff play?
