Item 5 – P/20881/000 – 2 Meyers Close

1.0 Additional comments received

- 1.1 Comments have been received from the Property Manager for the Oakbrook development raising concerns that the proposed change of use would contravene a covenant on the property. However, covenants are not a material planning consideration and no weight can be given to this matter.
- 1.2 Comments have been received from Ahmed Qurban (Commissioning Service Manager, Slough Children First):
- “We currently have 18 children placed in residential homes, of which 17 are out of borough, primarily due to limited local supply, we currently have 2 open referrals for residential placements.*
- Slough Children First are in support for this application of a residential children’s home in Slough, contingent of a Section 106 agreement to ensure we prioritise Slough children.”*
