<u>Member Motion on Feasibility Study into the construction of a link road 'land</u> <u>north of Taylor's Farm' - WITHDRAWN</u>

To be proposed by Cllr Geof Driscoll Seconded by Cllr Neil Reeve

Motion:

"The council recognises the importance of maintaining smooth traffic flows on our strategic road network (including the B1256). Whilst the current traffic evidence supporting the site allocation known as 'land north of Taylor's Farm' suggests that a new link road is not necessary, the council is mindful that circumstances can change over time.

As such, the council is RESOLVED:

- I. To make provision of £20,000 from the Local Plan budget to commission a feasibility study into the construction of a link road and active travel route between the site allocation known as 'land north of Taylor's Farm' and the A120.
- II. If feasible, to promote it to the county council for inclusion on any future road-building and infrastructure programmes, and for S106 contributions, should planning evidence justify it".
