The Mayor reflected on her year in office and her many engagements, and praised the work and support of the team of people around her.

It was moved by Councillor Best, seconded by Councillor Ashworth and RESOLVED unanimously that Councillor Roy Berg be elected Mayor of the London Borough of Waltham Forest until his successor is appointed.

Councillor Berg then addressed the Council. He stated that his mayorship theme for the year would be determination.

The Mayor announced:

- (b) that Father Alex Summers from St Peter-in-the-Forest Church act as his spiritual guide throughout his year as Mayor;
- (c) that during his term in office his fundraising activities for the year would be supporting veterans, ex-servicemen and women and their partners and families and increase visibility and awareness of the armed forces across the Borough; and (d) that he would be supporting young people to achieve their own ambitions by liaising with branches of cadets across Waltham Forest, and more generally young people moving from education into employment, particularly through apprenticeships and vocational careers.

The Council

- (f) appointed councillors to serve on the other Council bodies also listed in Appendix B;
- (g) **agreed** that the terms of reference of Standing Committees for 2023/24 shall be as set out in the Council's Constitution;
- (h) **noted** the Board of Directors of the Local Authority Trading Companies.
- (i) agreed that all councillors will be appointed as supernumerary members to substitute when a named member of a committee is unable to attend a meeting, in accordance with the Council's scheme for the appointment of substitute members; Group Leaders or Group Whips being able to agree substitutions in respect of members of their party groups; that in respect of the Health and Wellbeing Board, Executive members may be substituted only by other members of the Executive; and that in respect of any Scrutiny Committees, Executive members cannot serve as substitutes. (Note: The supernumerary arrangements do not apply to the Cabinet); and
- (j) agreed the consequential amendments to the Constitution arising from these decisions are to be finalised and published by the Director of Governance and Law.

9. PROGRAMME OF MEETINGS FOR 2023-24

- (b) **agreed** that the Chief Executive in consultation with the party Whips be authorised to agree any subsequent changes to the programme arising from clashes of membership following the appointment of committee memberships at this meeting.

- (b) **agreed** that all officers with delegated powers have power to further delegate those powers to other officers under s.101 of the Local Government Act 1972 or as provided for by any other legislation and may agree a scheme of delegation to officers for their service areas.
- (c) **delegated** to the Director of Governance and Law the power to make and publish the necessary changes to the Constitution and Scheme of Delegation to give effect to these decisions

11. APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES TO OUTSIDE BODIES / ORGANISATIONS IN 2023-24

The Council recognised that the eminent services that:





- 2. Except where specifically provided for in the Constitution, or a decision has been taken by myself or by Cabinet to delegate a decision in a particular matter to a specified individual or body, the following general arrangements shall apply in respect of matters which, under the Constitution are defined as key decisions:
- (a) Except where paragraph (b) applies, all key decisions shall be taken collectively by Cabinet;
- (b) Where a key decision relates only to a matter within a single Portfolio-holder's area of responsibility and/or has only a minimal impact on another executive portfolio in the view of the Director of Governance (or their representative), the decision may be taken by the relevant Portfolio-holder, subject to the Director of Governance being satisfied as to the following:
- i. that appropriate consultation has been undertaken on the matter concerned;
- ii. that all relevant matters are set out in a report that is considered by the Portfolio-Holder; and
- iii. a proper record is published of the Portfolio-Holder's decision.
- 3. I confirm the delegation of executive powers to officers as set out in:
- i. The General Scheme of Delegation;
- ii. The Council's Constitution; and
- iii.As set out in item 9 of this agenda.
- and that all officers with delegated powers may in turn delegate those powers to other officers in accordance with the Council's Constitution and legislation.
- 4. In the event of my absence, my statutory powers will be delegated to one of the Deputy Leaders on an annual rotation. This will be Cllr Ahsan Khan in May 2023 April 2024,

followed by Cllr Clyde Loakes from May 2024 – April 2025 and so on unless these positions are altered.

5. As executive leader, I reserve my statutory powers to make different arrangements for the discharge of executive functions to those set out above where this is desirable or necessary in the circumstances and following the receipt of legal advice, where appropriate.
