



Visitor and Operative Parking:

- On site parking during construction will be restricted Visitor and Operatives will be encouraged to use good, local transport links including sustainable modes of transport such as cycling
- Parking bays on Davies Lane and local roads to be utilised outside of restricted hours, as well as pay and display bays adjacent to Leytonstone High Road
- Parking bay suspensions may be required at certain times of the build and will be explored further with appointed contractor during development of a Detailed CLP, as well as construction method to limit number and size of construction vehicles

Site Deliveries:

- All deliveries and collections must be booked 24 hours in advance and will be considered on a first come first serve basis
- Unpermitted delivery hours are between 08.30 to 09.15 and 15.00 to 15.45 (Monday - Friday)
- Loading and unloading will be within the site boundary with delivery vehicles maintaining safe and free access along Davies Lane for vehicles and pedestrians/cyclists

Construction Method Statement:

- Site to be accessed from Davies Lane via secure access
- Time for work for all operations are to be carried out between the hours of 08.00 to 18.00 (Monday - Friday) and 08.00 to 13.00 (Saturday) only
- See site plan for loading and unloading and material storage locations All loading and unloading of plant and materials on the
- street to be done within protective barriers and outside of parking restrictions
- Concrete, if required for foundations, to be pumped from designated parking bays close to the site entrance outside of parking and road restrictions
- Construction method above ground such as lightweight timber frame construction to be explored to reduce amount and size of construction vehicle deliveries
- Welfare facilities to be provided on site by the contractor see site plan for location

Considerate Contractors Scheme:

- Contractor to be registered with Considerate Contractors Scheme (CCS) which promotes best practice beyond statutory requirements
- The Scheme is concerned about any area of construction activity that may have a direct or indirect impact on the image of the industry as a whole. The main areas of concern fall into three categories: the general public, the workforce and the environment

Site Boundary:

- based on interpretation of OS Map and topographical
- Should exact clarification of boundary be required then a third party boundary professional must be appointed
- Main contractor to ensure all construction, including both superstructure and substructure stays within site boundary at all times
